## The regional online health map

- of people in the West Midlands would **19%** have a consultation with an online doctor via the internet
- of people in Yorkshire and the Humber **69%** don't currently manage any aspect of their healthcare online
- 26% of people in the South West manage some element of their healthcare online
- 75% of people in the North West would book a doctor's appointment online
